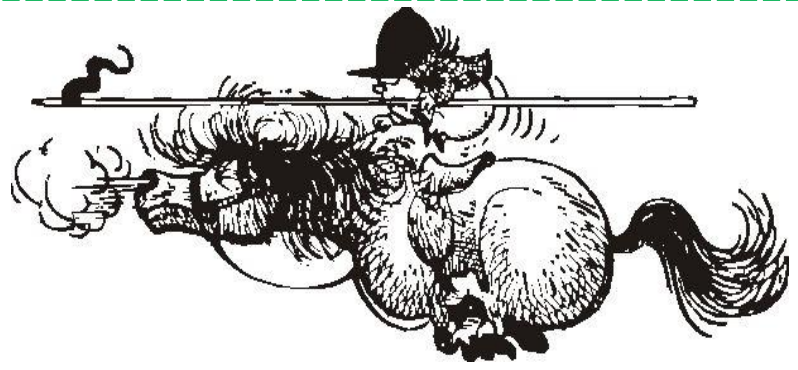

# PCWA State Tetrathlon Championships

This year Orange Grove HPC was represented by Suné Snyman at the Pony Club WA State Tetrathlon Championships held at Mortlock Pony Club on the 10-11<sup>th</sup> of April. The Tetrathlon consists of four phases- running 1-2km, swimming 100-200m, shooting a laser pistol 7-10m from the target and riding a Hickstead course (a jumping course mixed with both showjumping and cross country jumps).

Running- I had a pretty good run and was actually quite happy with it.

Swimming- I had a pretty good swim and also came first in my heat
