


Achievements!







PCWA State Festival

This year Orange Grove HPC was represented by two riders at the Pony Club WA State Festival held at the Murray Horse and Pony Club on the 6^{th} of June. The Pony Club State Festival is held every two years.

Tatum Hand

I can definitely say it was different to all the shows I've been to this year. It was a really long day and I had to manage myself the entire way. My day started at 4 o'clock to make sure everything was packed and ready, then to load the horse on and get there on time. All the way there I slept, just to get those extra few hours in, so I wasn't cranky or arguing with my horse. Not long after I got there, Dani showed up. I was so grateful because I didn't want to have to do the festival as the only Orange Grove representative. We walked Crystal and Jack around for a little bit to make sure they got used to the grounds.

First up I had dressage, it was definitely a wet day and the grass was pretty slippery. I had to really warm up Crystal because she was being really forward and a little argumentative. It took a while before I actually went in for my test, but then when I did, I was confident and ready to go. The start of the test went so well I was super happy and calm, her canter was well rounded, it was perfect, until we got to one canter corner and she slipped on the grass, luckily catching herself and continuing the test. It was a great effort all the way to the end and we placed 2nd.

After I had to quickly prepare her for jumping, when I realised, they had finished one of the rounds I was supposed to do, no warning, no nothing. I found it greatly unfair so I went to the office and I asked if I could do the 45cm am7 round instead and they let me. I quickly learned both courses and their jumps off's.

I did my 60cm am7 round first, I was nervous yet confident. I tried not to rush my basic round

before I hit my jump-off. It was a very nice course but after I finished, it started to really pour and I still had to do

my jump-off. I started the round, slowly picking up speed and making sure my horse didn't slip again. She fit two strides in a three-stride double and she was going faster than my horse has ever gone before. I only found out on Monday that I actually placed third in that round. I did my 45cm am7 next, I had to keep her moving before she went in. The round started great, we were really fast which I think triggered her acting out slightly, but Crystal isn't Crystal without putting a pigroot into a jump round. We ended up crossing paths and didn't make it to the jump-off, I was a little disappointed but I was still super proud of her.

It really started to rain and Nieve wasn't feeling well so I finished the day off doing some games. It took forever to get in and I was definitely saturated, I didn't think it was going to be raining that much. I started off with Western Bending which Crystal and I have been working on, it was so enjoyable when it



started. The person timing didn't press the button as I left so I had to repeat what I was doing. I believe that both of the efforts we did were great, my adrenaline was rushing and it felt amazing, Crystal had speed, finally, after 4-5 years. I did barrels next, that didn't go as well as I hoped, I somehow missed the end flag. Going around the barrels was messy and I just didn't enjoy it. We did 3 mugs last and that was even worse. I dropped a mug and it was just getting wetter and wetter, it wasn't so much fun.

I left before hacking but I had a great day overall. It was definitely an enjoyable experience; I hope I can do it again next year. You get to experience different disciplines and have fun along the way. Jumping was overall my favourite part of that day, it made me feel like I was flying, and it was nice to see my horse so happy doing a little bit of everything.

It was a bit of a bittersweet moment attending my last state festival in my pony club journey with my pony Jack. Even in the pouring rain, it was a lot of fun. I started my day off with my 45cm optimum time and just clipped a rail which caused us to lose rhythm but otherwise a very good round to finish in 4th place.

My next round was the 45cm AM7 which felt much better establishing a good rhythm to finish with a double clear round and placed 1st. My last event for the day was the novelties (western bending, 3 mug and barrel). As I was still slowly introducing Jack to mounted games, I decided to take it slow and steady especially in the rain. I was so impressed with his behaviour and finished my day pretty soaked. Unfortunately, I didn't stay to find out the results but was still so happy with how he went.
