



# PCWA State Hickstead Championships

#### What is a Hickstead?

A Hickstead is considered a Derby style competition where rustic Showjumping fences are combined with "natural" cross country obstacles, such as brush, ditches and banks. The Hickstead Championship consisted of 2 phases: Dressage and a combined Showjumping/Cross Country round.

On the 6<sup>th</sup> of November, 3 members from Orange Grove HPC attended the PCWA State Hickstead Championships held at Dardanup HPC. These riders were; Hailey Snyman, Sophie Dagnall and Suné Snyman. The girls did a fantastic job and rode through some challenging elements.

45cm 11 years and under: achieving 69.69% for their dressage test

#### Sophie Dagnall

65cm 13 years and under: achieving 64.06% for their dressage test

# Tip of the Month

Every month there will be a tip posted here to help remind riders and parents about some of the rules that need to be followed at rallies and competitions.

# Tip #9 New ruling for Competition Numbers

Under the new Pony Club Australia gear check rules for 2023, there has been a rule change for when competing you are at a pony club competition and have been given a rider number (e.g. ODEs). Previously you were only required to have one bridle or saddlecloth number worn on the left side of the horse. The new rule is that your bridle number or saddlecloth number must be visible on both sides of the horse
