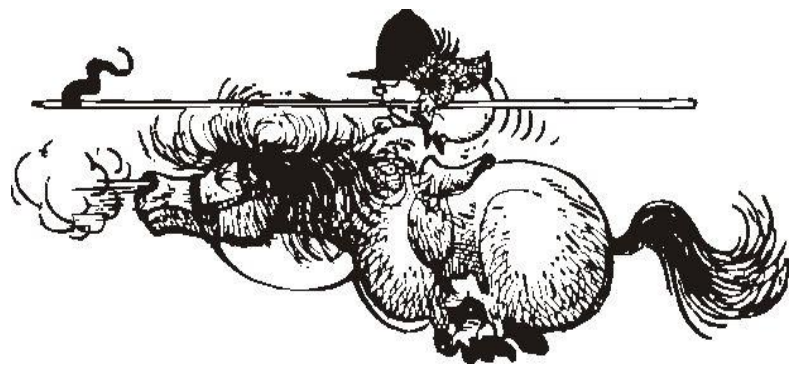

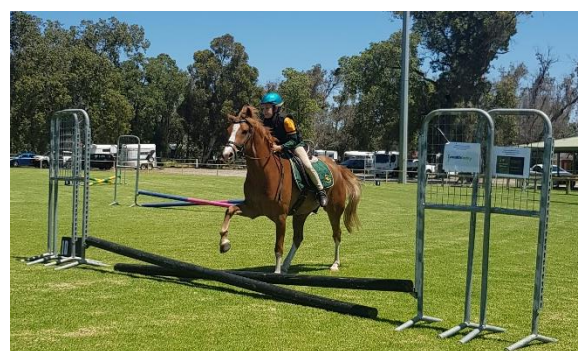

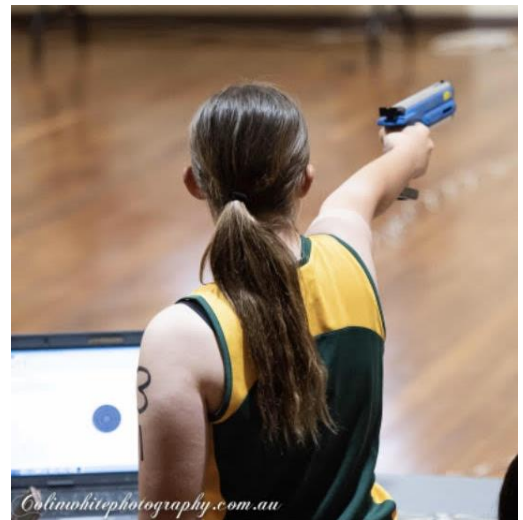

Teagan Christie and Amani Phantasie completed their first Eventing Championships together. We completed our dressage on Saturday morning and to have a great start to the weekend scoring 30.8 putting us into =2nd place. We then spent the rest of the night relaxing and dinner at the clubrooms.

We were up bright and early on Sunday morning to get ready for cross-country. We went out cross country with an awesome run, not looking at anything. I saw that I had plenty of time when I got to the water, so I decided to paddle first as the previous time we were at Capel, Digby had a look at the water. We then made it to the finish line double clear, still sitting in =2nd.

Showjumping was basically pretty much straight after cross country, so we didn't need much warmup. We did an awesome clear round which managed to put us into 1st place as the person that was winning had an unlucky rail. Great way to end the year, finishing on our dressage score.



PCWA State Tetrathlon Championships

Ella and her horse competed at their first state tetrathlon event together in the 70cm class. Ella did an amazing job managing to finish all four phases (running, swimming, shooting and riding a cross country round). Ella and her horse Dreeme Park Simply Gold came home with an individual result of 3rd place as well as placing 3rd with her team. Ella also managed to win an additional award for being the closest to the optimum time without going over in her class and was lucky enough to win a voucher.

What an incredible weekend it was competing at the state tetrathlon at Dryandra. I felt very under prepared going into this event with not being able to do any training whilst completing the last few months of my university degree. Our day started early on Saturday morning with a brisk 2km run. I was rather impressed that I managed to keep a decent pace and was fit enough to run the entire 2km. Next up we had our laser pistol shooting, Ella and I had a last-minute training session with Erin a few days before the competition. This phase was also another personal best for me even managing to shoot a couple 8.9/10 on the target. Our last phase for the day was 200m swim in the swimming pool. It was quite a shock to the body how cold the pool was when I dived in. Regardless, I swam my best and scored a decent time considering the last time I did swimming practice was back in February.



Going into the riding phase on Sunday, I was feeling quite excited as the course had some tricky lines, there was a good variety of jumps and Whisky was feeling ready. I was so proud of Whisky and our round, we managed to go clear but unfortunately ran out of time to shut the gate obstacle. It was such an improvement from last year's Tetrathlon where Whisky wouldn't even go near the gate.



We had a great team consisting of Ella Jones, Ella McCrum (Gidgegannup PC) and Emily Duane (Mingenew PC) and did well to finish in 3rd place in a competitive class. After 12 years of pony club, I was also lucky enough to win my very first rug placing 1st individually in my class. Whisky also won the Off the Track prize in our age group for being the best-performing thoroughbred/standardbred during the riding phase.
