PCWA State Eventing Championships

On the 23rd and 24th of October, 4 members from Orange Grove HPC attended the PCWA State Eventing Championships held at Murray HPC in Coolup. These riders were; Ella Jones, Sunè Snyman, Taliah Quinn and Teagan Christie. Sunè and Taliah were placed in a composite team in the 65cm class with two riders from Busselton and Capel Pony Club. Ella was also placed in a composite team in the 80cm class with three riders from Serpentine and Log Fence Pony Club.

<u>Ella Jones</u>

Ella had a busy weekend riding two horses at the event with Jasper competing in the 80cm class and Cody competing in the 45cm class. Ella and Jasper had a great start to day 1 completing their dressage test and scoring 28.8 penalties. Ella and Jasper finished off day 2 pretty strong going double clear (time and obstacles) in cross country and just taking 4 penalties in their showjumping round. Ella did a fantastic job to finish in 3rd place individually.

Ella and her new horse Cody had a great weekend together where they started with their dressage and showjumping on day 1. Ella and Cody did well in their dressage to score 31.8 penalties and just adding 8 penalties to their score from

their showjumping round. Ella and Cody finished day 2 with cross country on a good note where they came in double clear (time and obstacles). Ella and Cody placed 11^{th} individually.

<u>Sunè Snyman</u>

Sunè and Mickey had an amazing weekend competing in the 65cm class where they started day 1 with their dressage test and scoring 29.6 penalties. Sunè and Mickey continued with their great work on day 2 to go double clear (time and obstacles) in both their showjumping and cross country round. <u>Teagan Christie</u>


