

#### Teagan Christie


- Digby 1st place individual 110cm

## Tip of the Month

Every month there will be a tip posted here to help remind riders and parents about some of the rules that need to be followed at rallies.

## Tip #8 New ruling for Whips

Under the new horse welfare policy from Pony Club Australia there are new restrictions to using your whip at rallies and pony club events:

- No more than using the whip 2x per obstacle (e.g. horse refuses a jump you may only use the whip twice at that jump)
- You cannot use it after the last effort/obstacle in a competition round (e.g. at the end of your round)
