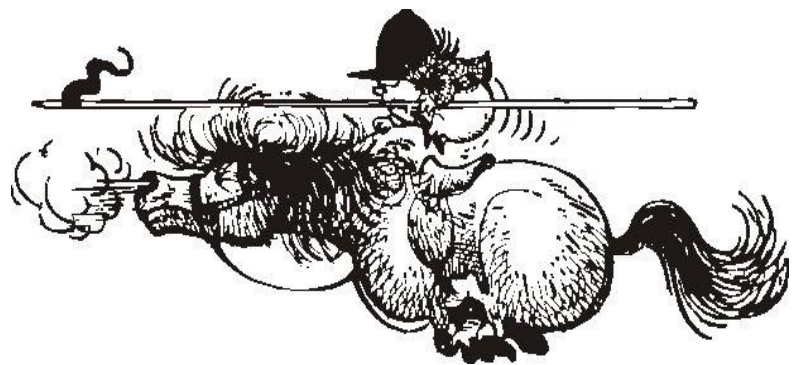

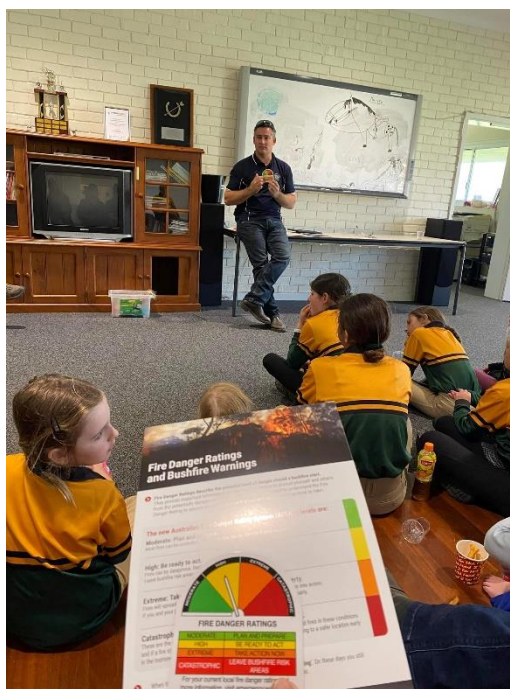

Sometimes it can be quite stressful to plan which competitions, training days and competitions to enter for the year as there is just so many to choose from and you often do not know where to start looking. We asked some of our club members on their opinions of what their recommended websites are. Here is what they suggested:

- ❖ Cavalletti - <https://www.cavalletti.com.au/event/>
 - Good for finding a range of events, training days and clinics
 - Unfortunately, Cavalletti is just an advertising forum for events but if you click on the event you are interested in and look under the forms section, it will usually have a link to either the entry form or programme.
- ❖ Equestrian Western Australia - <https://www.wa.equestrian.org.au/events/calendar>
 - Good for finding dressage, showjumping, eventing and show horse events
 - Some events listed on this website may require rider to have an Equestrian Australia (EA) Membership if they do not offer pony club classes.
- ❖ Global Entries - <https://www.globalentriesonline.com.au/>
 - Good for finding dressage, showjumping, eventing and show horse events
 - When on the home page, click on the view events button and then filter the calendar to Western Australia and the desired discipline
- ❖ JustGo (My Pony Club Portal)
 - once you are logged in, click the events, courses, and shop link at the top and filter the events you are looking for
- ❖ Ktrials - <https://www.ktrials.com.au/wp3EventSelect.aspx>
 - Good for finding eventing competitions (ODEs)
 - This will contain a mixture of Pony Club and Equestrian WA events
- ❖ Nominate - <https://www.nominate.com.au/equestdn/Nominate.aspx>
 - Good for finding a range of events, training days and clinic
- ❖ Pony Club Western Australia - <https://www.ponyclubwa.asn.au/calendar/>
 - Good for finding a range of Pony Club events
 - Unfortunately, the Pony Club WA website is just an advertising forum for events.
 - If it is an event organised by a pony club, it is recommended that you refer to that pony club's website or Facebook page for further details on how to enter
 - If it is an event organised by a state committee, it is recommended that you look under the ride tab on the Pony Club WA website and click on the desired discipline to find information on how to enter the event

Tip of the Month

Every month there will be a tip posted here to help remind riders and parents about some of the rules that need to be followed at rallies.

Tip #8

New ruling for Whips

Under the new horse welfare policy from Pony Club Australia there are new restrictions to using your whip at rallies and pony club events:

- No more than using the whip 2x per obstacle (e.g. horse refuses a jump you may only use the whip twice at that jump)
- You cannot use it after the last effort/obstacle in a competition round (e.g. at the end of your round)
