<u>Vaulting</u>

On the 5th of September, Aleska Wearne represented Orange Grove HPC at the PCWA State Active Riding Championships held at Serpentine HPC and competed in the vaulting competition.

Vaulting can be described as gymnastics and dancing on a horses' back. In competitions, vaulters may compete as individuals, pairs or in teams.

Vaulting competitions consist of exercises or dance moves that are compulsory meaning that the vaulters are expected to showcase these moves during their performance. These exercises may change based on the vaulter's training level and it is often performed as a freestyle with music.

Aleska did a wonderful job with learning and practising her routines to music with her partner. For this competition, Aleska performed some of her routines on a vaulting barrel demonstrated in the picture below.

We hope to see more of Aleska's beautiful vaulting performances in the future.

Tip of the Month

Every month there will be a tip posted here to help remind riders and parents about some of the rules that need to be followed at rallies.

Tip #7 - Stirrup Iron Fit When was the last time you checked that your stirrup irons fitted correctly? Did you know that on each side of the rider's boot (measure at the widest part) in the stirrup should have at least 1cm clearance and no more than 1.5cm clearance.
